PRODUCTION AND QUALITY DEPARTMENT WINS NAWASA'S FIRST EVER INDEPENDENCE ROAD RELAY

ST. GEORGE'S GRENADA, WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 4TH, 2015:- It was the perfect weather, the perfect setting and the perfect ending.....the Production & Quality Department is crowned Champions of NAWASA's First Ever Independence Road Relay.

The relay started with a bang at 10:30 a.m. today Wednesday February 4, 2015 at NAWASA's Dusty Highway Office unto True Blue Main road, with the first hand over taking place at Sugar Mill round-about.

The race continued towards the St. George's direction, with the second baton change by the Catholic Church in Grand Anse. From that location, athletes continued along the Grand Anse main road unto Ross Point Gap – Belmont, where the third leg came to an end and the fourth began.

During the fourth leg of the relay participants passed along the Belmont Road towards the Grenada Yacht Club on Kirani James Boulevard where batons changed hands for the final time.

Port Highway and The Carenage were the route for the final leg of the relay where the athletes accomplished the feat at the NAWASA's main office on the Carenage.

Five (5) departments participated in today's road relay - Administration, Finance, Planning and Development, Production and Quality & Transmission and Distribution.

The completion times:

1ST – P&Q – 37 minutes

2nd – Finance – 38 minutes

3rd – T&D- 42 minutes

4th – P&D- 44 minutes

5th – Finance – 48 minutes

6th - Finance (female team) – 50 minutes

7th - Administration- 58 minutes



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Athletes were escorted by the Royal Grenada Police Force.

The Independence Road Relay was all part of NAWASA's activities in observance of Grenada's 41st Anniversary of Independence.
